Changes in End of Day

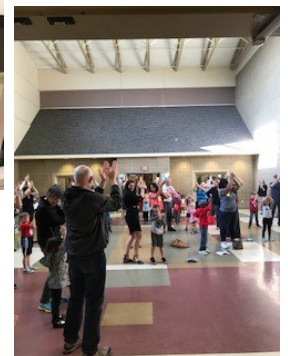
Transportation:
